

Key Components of a North River

FIRE & RESCUE VESSEL

Raised Aft Deck

Provides elevated work area for the crew and for helicopter rescues.

FLIR Camera

Low light and thermal imaging camera aids night and low visibility operations.

External Lights

Scene lights and remote search lights increase visibility for night operations.

Walk Around Deck

Enables full deck access around the entire cabin.

Dive Door

Makes it easier for rescue divers to get into and out of the water.

Cabin Side Doors

Provides multiple entry points to and from the cabin.

Drop Down Bow

Provides bow access to patients and rescue victims in the water or on the beach.

FIREFIGHTING & RESCUE FEATURES

1 Air-conditioned & Heated Cabin

Climate controlled cabin provides for crew and patient comfort.

2 Shock Mitigating Seats

Provides seating to reduce crew fatigue and protect crew in rough sea states.

3 In-cabin Patient Bench

Full length bench provides space to aid patients.

4 Bow & Stern Mounted Monitors

Provides firefighting and fire-suppression capabilities to entire boat.

5 Radios

Offers clear ship-to-shore, vessel-to-vessel communications as well as public address capabilities.

6 Electronics Package

Multifunction monitors provide navigation, depth sounding, side scan imaging and systems monitoring.

7 Radiation Detection

Enables radiation and chemical detection capabilities.

8 Cameras

Records live video for incident response reporting.
